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Ticket information / Box Office

Tickets

If you want to go and watch something at the festival, you need to buy a ticket for each show you want to go and see. Because different venues have different capacities, there is no 'festival wristband' or 'weekend ticket' – you choose exactly what you want to see and buy tickets accordingly.

Advance tickets

You can buy tickets for all of the shows by following the links from our website (abercomedyfest.co.uk). Any shows that have sold out will be clearly marked as such on the listings page.

All advance tickets bought online will be **PRINT AT HOME**. If you buy tickets in advance, please ensure that you bring the details with you on the weekend – either on your phone or printed off. **You will need to present these details at the venue entrance when you arrive for a show.**

How to buy show tickets on the day

Any shows with tickets remaining on the day can still be purchased via the festival website / app before the start of the show. Tickets can also be purchased right up until the start of each show in person from the Festival Box Office.

The Box Office will be open during the following hours across the weekend to purchase tickets with cash or card:

FAQs

I want to come to the festival! How do I get in?

Because the shows are based in multiple venues within the Arts Centre and Student Union building, the festival 'site' is free to roam. You just purchase tickets to the individual events that you'd like to see. Whether that's just one show, or as many as you can fit in across the three days, you just pay for what you go to watch.

Where can I buy tickets?

Tickets are available in advance from our website (www.abercomedyfest.co.uk) and via our app (courtesy of our super-talented friends at Devfusion.net).

On the weekend, you can purchase tickets from our Festival Box Office within the Arts Centre building. There you'll be able to grab a programme, see what shows are still available and purchase new tickets!

Will there be any tickets left on the weekend?

There will definitely be some available but there will also be shows that have sold out beforehand. If there are specific shows you are heading to see, it is advisable to book in advance. Any sold out shows will be listed as such on the website.

What do I do when I get there?

Once you have your tickets in hand, all you need to do is find your venue and turn up 15 minutes before the start of the show.

This year, all the venues are within the Aberystwyth Arts Centre building so getting from one venue to another has never been easier if you have multiple shows booked!

The rest of the time is up to you! Aberystwyth has lots to offer whether you fancy a bite to eat, a little tipple or head to the seafront and take in the beautiful coastal scenery.

I have an access question. Where can I find the answer?

You can check the access section of the Aberystwyth Comedy Festival website to see if that can answer your question.

There is also the comprehensive access section of the Aberystwyth Arts Centre website which provides lots of useful information with plans and interactive guides:

On the weekend, there will also be an Accessibility Officer on hand at the Festival Box Office to help with any queries in person.

Can I take drinks into shows with me?

Yes, as long as they are purchased from the Arts Centre or Student Union bars. They have a wide range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks available before and after the shows.

Are there any places to eat?

Yes, the Arts Centre has a lovely cafe serving a superb selection of food – from hot meals to grab and go options you'll be able to refuel in between shows.

If you want to explore further, there is a wide selection of restaurants, cafes and food outlets on offer in town. Whether you are heading for a sit-down meal or grabbing something on the go, there are plenty of options to suit all tastes and budgets.

Where can I stay?

Aberystwyth has over 50 hotels, guest houses, B&Bs and serviced apartments within walking distance of the town centre and many more just outside. You can find more details via your preferred online booking platform.

What if I have more questions?

You can get in touch with us in advance via all the usual channels on social media. On the weekend itself we have a dedicated information point at our Official Festival Box Office in the Arts Centre.

Accessibility

Little Wander is committed to continually improving accessibility at all our events and the following measures are in place to assist customers with access needs at the festival:

Dedicated Accessibility Email

For any access queries in advance of the festival, we have created a dedicated contact email address: accessibility@littlewander.co.uk

This email address can also be used during the festival weekend along with in person enquiries at the Access Information Point (see below).

Access requests can also be added as notes on the festival ticketing site when booking online. These will be passed on to venue staff ahead of shows.

HYNT tickets

HYNT is a national access scheme that works across arts venues in Wales to make sure there is a consistent offer available for visitors with an impairment or specific access requirement, and their Carers or Personal Assistants. We are part of the HYNT scheme as we believe it offers our disabled customers the very best practice in fair ticketing policy and accessibility.

HYNT members need to contact boxoffice@littlewander.co.uk with their membership number before purchasing tickets so we can set you up on our box office system accordingly.

Access Information Point

Throughout the festival weekend, we have an Access Information Point at the Festival Box Office with a dedicated staff member to answer any queries, provide feedback or suggest improvements surrounding access at the event.

Customers with access requirements are encouraged to visit the Access Information Point ahead of going into shows. That way, our team can

assist as much as possible in advance – including issuing priority wristbands where appropriate.

The Access Information Point also has a small stock of useful items (including a wheelchair, ear defenders and more) which are available to borrow free of charge (subject to availability).

Venues / Lleoliadau

Aberystwyth Comedy Festival returns once again, bringing an exciting weekend programme of 50 live events taking place in 7 venues within Aberystwyth Arts Centre - Wales' largest arts centre and recognised as a 'national flagship for the arts' PLUS an additional space across the piazza at the Student Union.

Aberystwyth Arts Centre

The Arts Centre is located on the University campus which is well signposted and has a big car park to the rear of the venue (and it's free on weekends!) including a number of spaces for blue badge holders. Alongside great views over the town, the Arts Centre also has a lovely cafe, bars and shop to ensure you have everything you need to relax in between shows!

For those planning to walk up from town, leave yourself at least half an hour and be prepared for a fairly steady incline all the way!

The Great Hall

Our largest festival space with a capacity of over 800 and accessed from one of four doors depending on where you are seated! Members of the stewarding team will be on hand for all performances to help direct you.

Y Neuadd Fawr

Dyma'n gofod mwyaf gyda lle i dros 800 a mynediad iddo o un o bedwar drws yn dibynnu ar le 'rydych yn eistedd. Bydd aelodau o'n tîm stiwardio wrth law ar gyfer pob perfformiad i'ch cyfeirio i'ch sedd.



Theatr Y Werin

This is a wonderful modern performance space with a raked seating capacity of 300. It is accessed from upstairs in the Arts Centre by the main bar, serviced by a lift from the ground floor.

Theatr Y Werin

Mae hwn yn ofod perfformio modern gwych gyda thros 300 o seddi. Mae mynediad iddo o'r llawr uchaf yn y Ganolfan trwy'r prif far, gyda lifft o'r llawr gwaelod.



The Studio

The 100 capacity round venue is the home of Little Wander's regular Comedy Club in Aberystwyth - a favourite with acts and audience alike! The entrance / exit is by the upstairs bar in the Arts Centre and can be accessed via stairs or the lift next to the shop.

Y Stiwdio Y Stiwdio

Gron gyda lle i 100 yw cartref Clwb Comedi misol Little Wander yn Aberystwyth - ac mae'n ffefryn gyda pherfformwyr a chynulleidfaoedd fel ei gilydd! Mae'r fynedfa / allanfa wrth y bar i fyny'r grisiau yn y Ganolfan a gellir ei chynrraedd trwy gerdded i fyny neu gymryd y lifft wrth y siop.



The Cinema

This stylish, modern cinema has a capacity of 110 and is located by the main entrance, right next to the Box Office. With raked (not to mention soft, cushioned) seating, it has a cosy and intimate atmosphere.

Y Sinema

Mae gan y sinema fodern, steilus hon 110 o seddi ac fe'i lleolir wrth y brif fynedfa, ger bwys y Swyddfa Docynnau. Gyda seddi meddal, cyfforddus ar oledf, mae ganddi awyrgylch clyd a phersonol.



Dance Studio 3

Dance Studio 3 is located on the lower level of the Arts Centre, opposite the ceramics gallery just inside the concourse entrance foyer.

Stiwdio Ddawns 3

Lleoliad newydd arall i'r ŵyl llynedd yw Stiwdio Ddawns 3 a leolir ar lefel isaf y Ganolfan, gyferbyn â'r oriel serameg, jyst tu mewn i ddrws y cyntedd.



2D Room

Located on the top level of the Arts Centre, the 2D Room is one of our most intimate festival venues. A 50 seat room, it is accessed up at the end of a slightly sloping corridor by the entrance to the Theatre bar.

Ystafell 2D
